Access to world renowned orthopaedic care at The Steadman Clinic has never been easier. The Steadman Clinic is located in Vail in the central Rocky Mountains of Colorado, 100 miles west of Denver and just 30 miles east of the Vail/Eagle County Airport (EGE). Interstate 70 is a scenic and direct route into Vail from just about anywhere.

Denver International Airport (DEN)

Denver International Airport is located 120 miles (less than 2 hours) east of Vail and is a non-stop destination for major domestic and international airlines. Car rentals, taxi and shuttle services are available.

Directions from Denver International Airport

Take Pena Boulevard from Denver International Airport to Interstate 70 (I-70) west

Proceed for approximately 120 miles to the Vail exit #176

At the traffic circle, take the 4th exit onto Vail Rd

At the next traffic circle, continue straight to stay on Vail Rd

Turn right at the stop sign, heading west on W Meadow Dr

Turn right after .2 miles into the Vail Valley Medical Center. The Steadman Clinic is located inside.

Vail/Eagle County Airport (EGE)

The Vail/Eagle County Airport is located just 30 miles (40 minutes) from Vail and is serviced by American, Continental, Delta and United airlines. Car rentals, taxi and shuttle services are available.

Jet Center at Eagle County Airport

Located just 30 miles (40 minutes) from Vail for private and chartered flights

Directions from Vail/Eagle County Airport

Take Cooley Mesa Road (main airport road) to Highway 6. Take a right on Highway 6. You will be heading east

Follow Highway 6 to signs for Interstate 70 (I-70) east

Proceed on I-70 for approximately 25-30 minutes, to the Vail exit #176

At the traffic circle, take the 2nd exit onto Vail Rd

Turn right at the stop sign, heading west on W Meadow Dr

Turn right after .2 miles into the Vail Valley Medical Center. The Steadman Clinic is located inside.

Weather & Altitude

Weather

Temperatures and weather can change rapidly in the Rocky Mountains. Bring extra clothes, check weather reports before leaving home and be prepared. The sun is more powerful in the thin mountain air, so wear sunscreen and sunglasses/goggles with ultraviolet protection.

Altitude

Our clinic sits 8,150 feet above sea level. Some people experience altitude sickness during their visit which may include a headache, nausea, or unusual tiredness. These symptoms usually go away in a day or two. If they grow worse, or if you are worried, be sure to consult a doctor. Some tips to avoid these symptoms include eating foods high in carbohydrates, drinking more water and reducing your alcohol, coffee and sodium intake
