The Steadman Philippon Research Institute (SPRI) collects patient-centered outcomes data on every patient who visits The Steadman Clinic. This data allows our clinic physicians and scientists to translate their research findings into improved patient outcomes and care worldwide. SPRI currently manages more than 20 million data-points in its clinical database, making

it one of the largest orthopaedic outcomes databases in the world. Data for every knee patient at The Steadman Clinic since 1993 has been entered into SPRI's database, with hundreds of data-points collected per patient.

By combining SPRI's Preventive, Innovative and Regenerative research with our experienced physicians, we deliver an overall better patient experience. In addition, one of SPRI's research departments, Center for Regenerative Sports Medicine, provides the opportunity to discover ways to preserve joints through stem cell research.

Center for Regenerative Sports Medicine

With his extensive knowledge in the areas of stem cell, tissue engineering regenerative medicine, Johnny and Huard, PhD, Director of SPRI's Center for Regenerative Sports Medicine (CRSM) department, advances the pioneering work in regenerative sports medicine and stem cell research. Ultimately, CRSM gives patients of The Steadman Clinic the opportunity to recover faster and stronger. The clinic's team of physicians and the SPRI researchers envision every person having the opportunity to harvest his or her own stem cells and re-inject them into the body to help delay various aging processes such

as osteoporosis or osteoarthritis as well as speed up recovery from injury or illness. The quality of research within SPRI, has led to many accomplishments in orthopaedic care; including the official designation as an USOC National Medical Center.


Designated National Medical Center

Surgery

When surgery is necessary to correct an orthopaedic disorder or injury, our clinics have state-of-the-art operating suites standing nearby. Equipped with the most advanced instrumentation and equipment, these operating rooms are staffed by a highly trained group of nurses who assist the physicians during surgery, and monitor patients in the recovery room. If surgery is recommended, the operative plan and the recovery process are thoroughly explained to the patient by the physician.

Emergency Information

Our clinics will always have a physician on call in case of after hours emergencies. If you need to contact a physician when the clinic is closed, call the regular clinic number and our answering service will notify the physician on call to contact you.

Clinic Locations

The Steadman Clinic suites are located on the second and third floor of the Vail Valley Medical Center in Vail. The Steadman Clinic MRI is located on the first floor.

The Steadman Clinic also has suites in Edwards and Frisco, Colorado.

Insurance and Billing

Due to the ever changing insurance industry and multiple plans offered by each insurance carrier, it is best to confirm The Steadman Clinic's participation by calling your insurance company. Please provide them with the following information:

Many insurance carriers require that we collect co-pays and/or deductibles from the patient. If you have an office visit co-pay for a specialist, you will be expected to pay that amount at the time of service. Due to federal laws, as well as our individual contracts with the insurance carriers, we are prohibited from waiving these fees.

Other Insurance Carriers

If we are not contracted with an insurance plan, it is our policy to collect 100% of the bill at time of service. As a courtesy, we will submit the claims to the insurance carrier on your behalf. If the carrier does not pay on the claim, you will be contacted for the remaining payment on your account.

Workers Compensation

For patients whose injury is work related, you must provide the schedulers with all pertinent information such as insurance carrier, claim number, date of injury, adjustor's name, phone and fax number before the appointment is scheduled.

Referrals

A referral is sometimes required in order to be seen by a specialist. You will need to contact your insurance company to find out if a referral is needed. You must ensure that we have the referral prior to your visit, otherwise you will be financially responsible at the time of service.

Private Pay

If you are private pay, you will be expected to pay in full at the time of service.



Capabilities

Physical Therapy

Utilizes a variety of procedures to restore function to the body, reduce pain and help prevent future injury.

Sports and Orthopaedic Rehabilitation

Evidence and outcome-focused approach, our therapists use innovative treatment techniques to help patients return to the activities and sports they love to do.

Aquatic Therapy

Non-weight-bearing properties of water create an ideal rehabilitation environment, especially for post-operative patients or those with back and spine injuries.

Lymphedema Therapy

Incorporates swelling-reducing massage to improve lymphatic flow and help speed recovery.

Men's and Women's Health Programs

Specialists evaluate and treat incontinence, pregnancy and post-partum pain, overactive bladder, pelvic pain/weakness, prolapse, interstitial cystitis and tailbone pain.

<u>Pilates</u>

Classical Pilates mixed with traditional physical therapy allows patients to be active in their care and maintain strength.

Dry Needling

Reduces muscle pain and dysfunction associated with trigger points.

Hand Therapy Conditions

Includes fractures, tendon injuries, peripheral nerve injuries, carpal tunnel syndrome, crush injuries and repetitive motion disorder.

Vestibular Rehabilitation

Non-invasive and drug-free therapy option for combating dizziness, vertigo, imbalance and other inner ear disorders.


